## FORCED PARENT VACCINATIONS WILL REDUCED PARENTAL PARTICIPATION

## POTENTIALLY DECREASE ACADEMIC SUCCESS OF CALIFORNIA STUDENTS

## **OPPOSE SB792**

Amendments to SB792 require all daycare and preschool workers, as well as PARENT VOLUNTEERS, to have MMR, Dtap, and annual flu shot.

- The recently passed law SB277, requires all <u>students to be completely vaccinated</u> prior to attending preschools and daycare.
- SB792 is redundant offering no additional health benefits since students are protected by their own vaccines.
- Parent involvement remains a strong predictor of academic achievement; vaccine mandates create a barrier and will reduce parental participation.

Thirty years of research confirms that family involvement is a powerful influence on children's achievement in school (Eagle, 1989; Henderson & Berla, 1994; U.S. Department of Education, 1994; Ziegler, 1987). When families are involved in their children's education, children earn higher grades and receive higher scores on tests, attend school more regularly, complete more homework, demonstrate more positive attitudes and behaviors, graduate from high school at higher rates, and are more likely to enroll in higher education than students with less involved families. <sup>1</sup>
